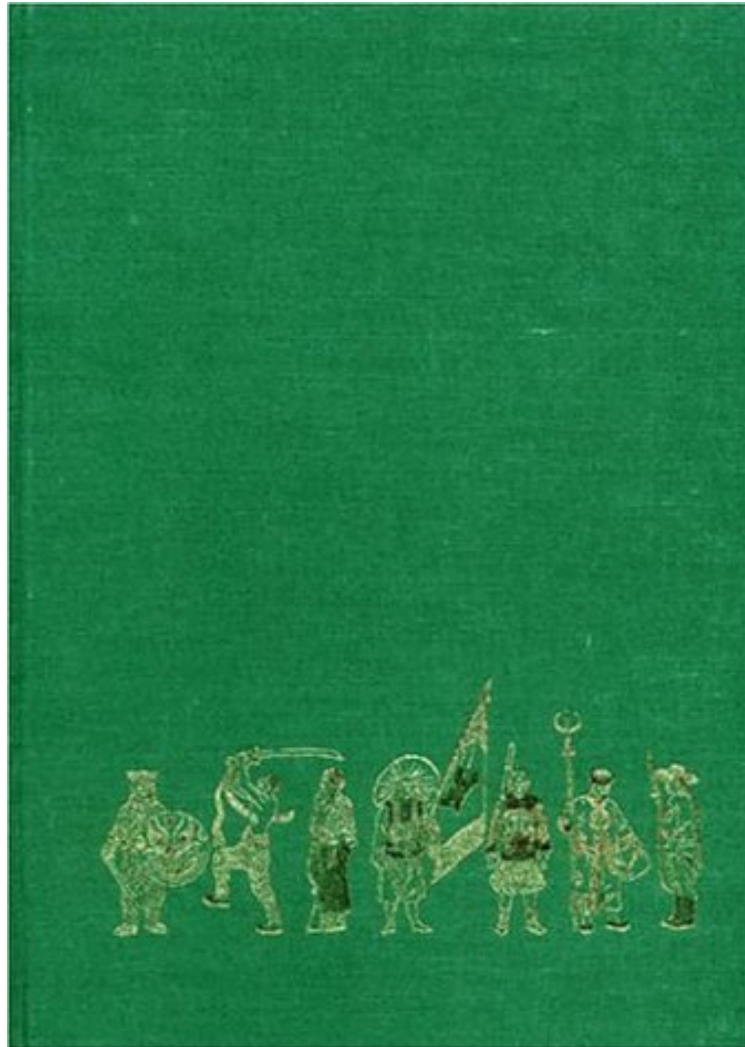

Century.The book contains excellent line drawings of flags and the dress of the warriors of this neglected era. The text concisely describes these forgotten campaigns, the organization, tactics and weapons of the different armies.Although there are other books on the Boxer Rebellion and even at least one or two about the Taiping Rebellion, they're millitary aspects are not as well covered as in this work.Also covered in this book are the Miao, Nien, Panthay and Tungan rebellions. A chapter is

devoted to the the "Ever-Victorious Army" and other colorful groups of American, British and French mercenary-led forces. The savage and brutal war waged by Chinese colonists against the native tribes of Formosa gets it's due. The corrupt and somewhat feeble, if enormous Manchu (Imperial) army is covered in great detail. The book also has a chapter covering the Mongols in this period.
