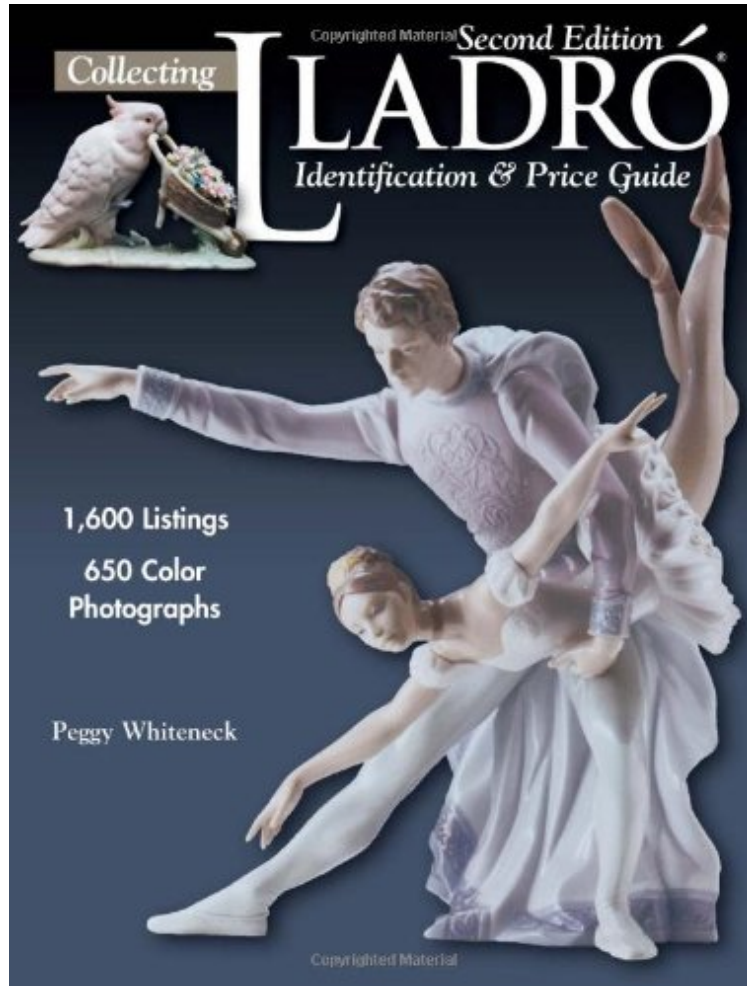

And also source out Lladro examples from a more varied selection of collectors. A view of how they are stored in display cabinets at
