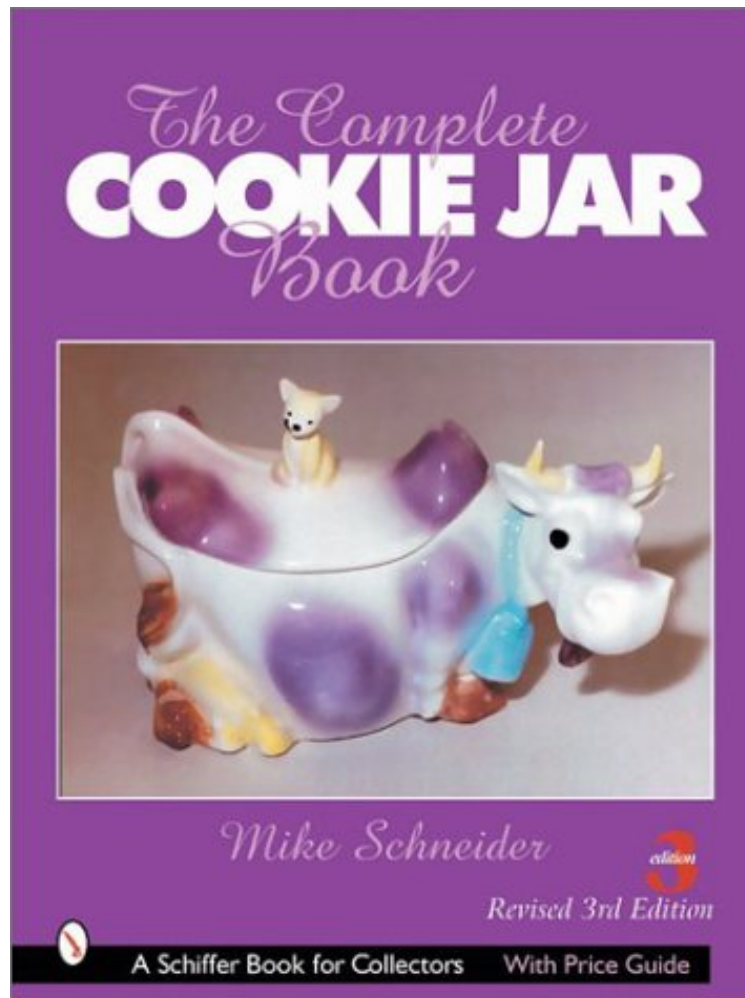

With all of the reproductions out there today, it is hard for beginning collectors to know which cookie jars are original and which ones are reproduction.Mike's innovative approach to photographing the cookie jars from the top of the finial gives collectors a whole new perspective on what the cookie jars look like and I think this is important.Other authors of collectibles books owe Mike a debt of gratitude.
