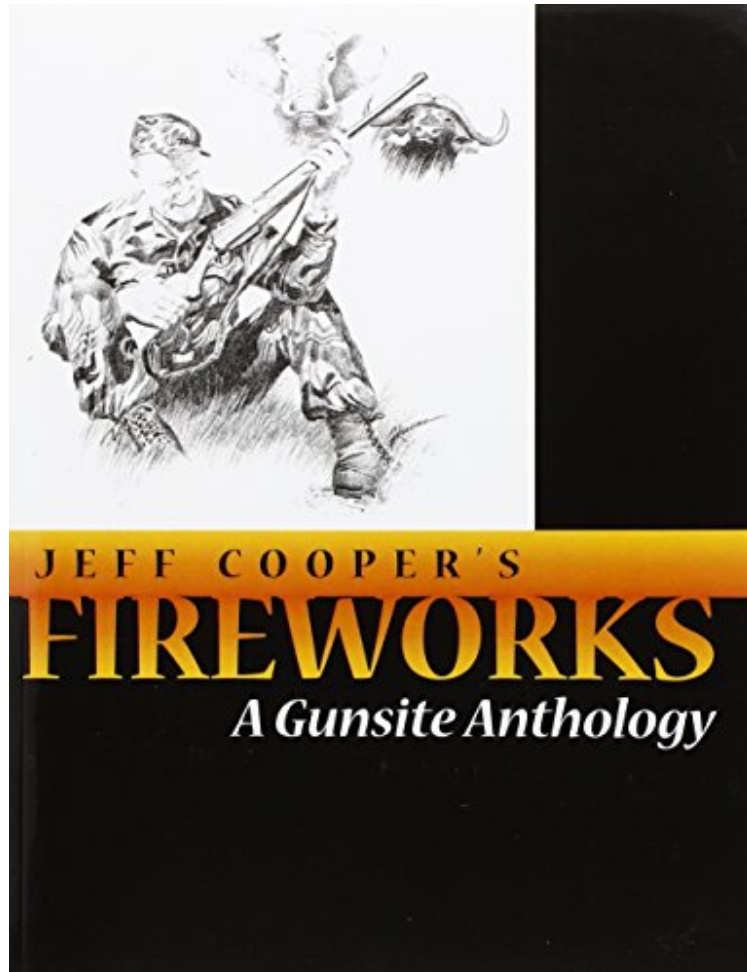

Among all authors on the subjects of firearms, personal defense, hunting, and related topics, he is simply the very best, the nonpareil. His style and skill should be models for any author in any field. His prose is perfectly clear, but also incisive, varied, and breathtaking in its versatility. When he explains and expounds, his sentences land like the judgments of an oracle, admitting no quibble, so clearly does he make his case. When he tells a story, it can be gripping, lighthearted, humorous, or lavish in the praise of a great hero, but in all cases well-paced. His essays, typically on political or cultural topics, have the delivery of graceful hammer blows. Along with this collection, I particularly recommend another, "To Ride, Shoot Straight, and Speak the Truth." I have had these in hardcopy for as

However, the publisher's choice of a large trim size (8"x11"), big font size, and extremely long rows of text make this very difficult to read without making one's eyes and neck sore from craning back and forth over the page. From a technical perspective, this is an extremely poorly designed book. The publisher should reset and redesign the interior of this title in a smaller trim size in order to make it easier to read and more portable.
