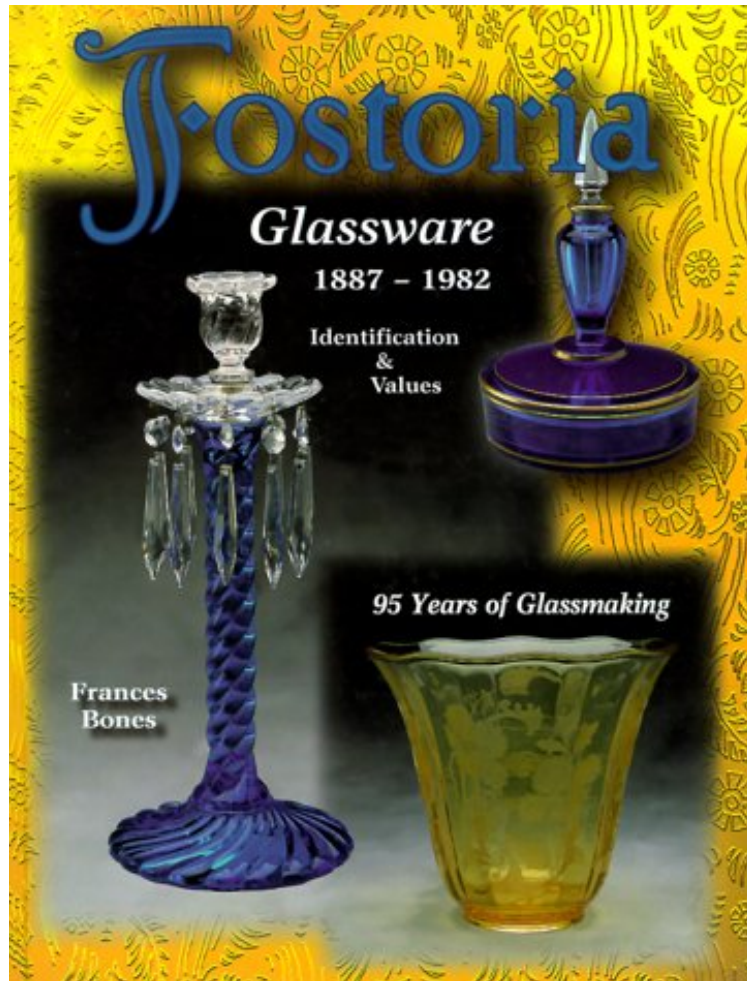


Fostoria Glassware, 1887-1982: Identification Values: 95 Years of Glassmaking

Cuttings, etchings, needle etchings, and pressed patterns of dinnerware are presented, as well as catalog pages of stemware, tumblers, candlesticks, oil lamps, and hundreds more pieces. In the spring of 1998 she and Lee Roy Fisher published *The Standard Encyclopedia of American Silverplate*. In 1999 she published *Fostoria Glassware 1887 - 1982*. REVIEW: This book covers 95 years of glassmaking from the Fostoria Glass Company, 1887 - 1982. This identification guide of the company's products is easy to use. The glass presented is divided alphabetically into 19 sections. Cut, Etched, Needle Etched, and Pressed categories are featured.
